Subject: CONSUMER PRICE INDEX

Under the negotiated collective bargaining agreements, the change in the Consumer Price Index (U.S. City Average, Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers) reported for each of the twelve months ending with the month of March 2015, indicates a 1.0% increase. Employees covered by agreements with cost of living adjustments that include provisions for 1% to 2%, or 1% to 4% cost of living adjustment will receive a 1.0% salary increase effective July 2015. Employees covered by agreement with cost of living adjustments that include provision for 2% to 4%, and unrepresented personnel will receive a 2% salary increase effective July 2015.

The new salary schedules reflecting the 1.0% or 2% salary increase for each applicable labor agreement will be sent to you sometime prior to June 15, 2015. Please call our office if you have any questions regarding this matter.
